Property Sales

September Property sales were 72, up 30.9% from 55 in September of 2016 and -16.3% lower than the 86 sales last month. September 2017 sales were at a mid level compared to September of 2016 and 2015. September YTD sales of 637 are running 2.9% ahead of last year's year-to-date sales of 619.



The Median Sales Price in September was \$582,500, down -11.7% from \$660,000 in September of 2016 and down -4.8% from \$612,000 last month. The Average Sales Price in September was \$688,917, down -10.7% from \$771,344 in September of 2016 and down -12.6% from \$788,401 last month. September 2017 ASP was at the lowest level compared to September of 2016 and 2015.



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
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Inventory & MSI

The Total Inventory of Properties available for sale as of September was 474, up 1.5% from 467 last month and down -21.4% from 603 in September of last year. September 2017 Inventory was at the lowest level compared to September of 2016 and 2015.


A comparatively lower MSI is more beneficial for sellers while a higher MSI is better for buyers. The September 2017 MSI of 6.6 months was at its lowest level compared with September of 2016 and 2015.


MSI is the # of months needed to sell all of the Inventory at the monthly Sales Pace



Market Time


The average Days On Market(DOM) shows how many days the average Property is on the Market before it sells. An upward trend in DOM tends to indicate a move towards more of a Buyer's market, a downward trend a move towards more of a Seller's market. The DOM for September was 108, up 30.1% from 83 days last month and down -19.4% from 134 days in September of last year. The September 2017 DOM was at its lowest level compared with September of 2016 and 2015.





The Selling Price per Square Foot is a great indicator for the direction of Property values. Since Median Sales Price and Average Sales price can be impacted by the 'mix' of high or low end Properties in the market, the selling price per square foot is a more normalized indicator on the direction of Property values. The September 2017 Selling Price per Square Foot of \$273 was down -1.4% from \$277 last month and down -5.9% from \$290 in September of last year.

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Selling Price vs Listing Price


The Selling Price vs Listing Price reveals the average amount that Sellers are agreeing to come down from their list price. The lower the ratio is below 100% the more of a Buyer's market exists, a ratio at or above 100% indicates more of a Seller's market. The September 2017 Selling Price vs List Price of 93.0% was up from 92.7% last month and up from 91.1% in September of last year.

Inventory / New Listings / Sales

'This last view of the market combines monthly inventory of Properties for sale along with New Listings and Sales. The graph shows the basic annual seasonality of the market as well as the relationship between these items. The number of New Listings in September 2017 was 129, up 67.5% from 77 last month and down -25.0% from 172 in September of last year.



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
